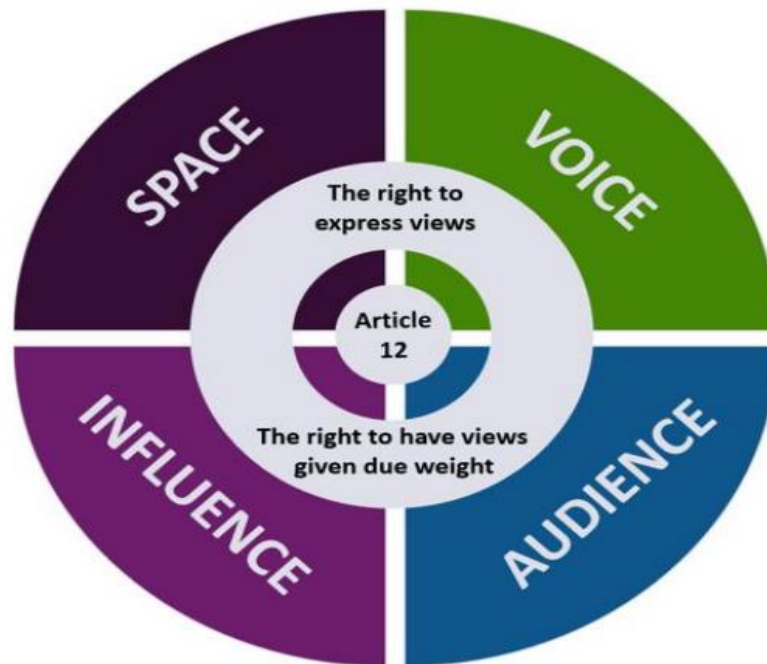


Our own professional voice must be visible and owned, it is part of professional transparency and accountability. The use of "I" as a professional is encouraged.
